

GACE Assessment Registration Information for UGA Students

This information is for candidates enrolled in a teacher preparation program, or in School Library Media, School Psychology, or School Counseling program.

What are the GACE assessments?

The GA Assessment for the Certification of Educators (GACE) is Georgia's state-approved educator certification assessment program. The purpose of the assessment is to assure that the knowledge and skills acquired by prospective Georgia educators are aligned with state and national standards for educator preparation and with state standards for the P-12 student curriculum – the Common Core Performance Standards (CCGPS).

Who takes the GACE?

The GACE assessments are taken by individuals. . .

- seeking admission to an educator preparation program for initial certification
- seeking educator certification in the State of Georgia (either for initial certificate or to add fields after initial)
- seeking to become highly qualified in a core academic subject.

Can I Take the GACE Whenever I Want?

- Yes – if you are taking the GACE Program Admission Assessment (formerly GACE Basic Skills) OR if you are taking the GACE content assessment as part of your program requirements for an advanced degree which leads to initial certification. For example, MAT students do not need eligibility granted by UGA.
- No – for candidates taking a GACE content assessment for initial certification. Candidates must be designated eligible by their program provider (UGA) to take the content GACE. Eligibility will be granted prior to the semester before student teaching.

How do I establish Eligibility for taking the GACE Content Assessment?

If you are enrolled in a Georgia state-approved educator preparation program within a college or university, you must be approved to test by your program provider in order to take a GACE assessment for Georgia certification.

NOTE: GaPSC will automatically grant testing eligibility for the GACE Program Admission assessment (formerly GACE Basic Skills) and for all students taking the GACE for admission to a postgraduate program (MAT, MEd, EdS, EdD and PhD) that lead to initial certification.

Steps to Establish Eligibility to Test:

1. Create a [MyPSC](#) account. If you already have an account, log in and write down your account number. **NOTE: You must make sure that your MyPSC account name matches exactly the name on your valid identification document (Driver's License or Passport; NOT your UGA ID card) you take with you to the test site for admittance.**
2. Log into your MyPSC account. Update your profile information, such as address and phone number and make sure your name is your full legal name as displayed on your legal document you will use at the time of testing. If you need to change your name, go to <http://www.gapsc.com/Certification/Formsandapplications.aspx>, print out and complete the 3-page application in your new name and either mail or fax it to the PSC as directed on the application.
3. Choose University of Georgia in the list of providers that pops up and enter your 810#. **IF YOU RECEIVE A MESSAGE SAYING YOUR PROVIDER HAS NOT MADE YOU ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE GACE, PLEASE EMAIL UGAGACE@uga.edu.** You will not be able to go any further until UGA has established that you are eligible to test. Proceed to #6 if you are able to choose UGA as your provider.
4. Claim your program by clicking 'Programs' in the heading in the MyPSC banner at the top of the page and confirm your program. For example, Mathematics or History. Click the 'ADD' button.
 - a. Confirm your choice by typing 'yes' in the space provided then click the 'FINISH' button. Clicking 'QUIT' will cancel your choice and allow you to try again.
5. Click on the 'Assessments' link at the top of the MyPSC homepage.
6. Scroll down to find the reason why you want to take a GACE assessment and select **reason #2**.
7. Request eligibility from UGA. You have now successfully transmitted your profile and eligibility to the testing company (ETS)



How do I register?

You can register online or by phone for all assessments. You will need your MyPSC account handy.

Scores are generally available four weeks from the beginning of the testing window in which you tested.
